The United States Attorney charges that:

**COUNT I**  
**(Willfully Filing a False Tax Return)**

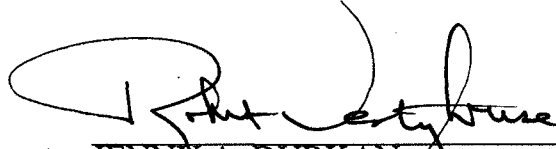
