

2 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on October 28, 2002 at 10:30 a.m., or as soon  
3 thereafter as the matter can be heard by the above-entitled Court, located at 880 Front Street,  
4 San Diego, California 92110, Second Floor, Room 12, Plaintiff The Society of Lloyd's  
5 ("Plaintiff") will and hereby does move the Court for summary judgment in favor of  
6 Plaintiff and against Defendants Rowland W. Johnston, Frank F. Lin, Robert K. Lowry,  
7 Richard D. Rosenblatt, and Robert L. Swisher (collectively, the "Defendants").

8 Pursuant to said motion, Plaintiff seeks recognition and enforcement, under  
9 California's Uniform Foreign Money Judgment Recognition Act (the "Recognition Act"),  
10 California Code of Civil Procedure §§ 1713 *et seq.*, of final judgments entered by the High  
11 Court of Justice, Queen's Bench Division in London, England against each of the  
12 Defendants (the "Judgments").

13 Pursuant to said motion, Plaintiff seeks recognition and enforcement, under  
14 California's Uniform Foreign Money Judgment Recognition Act (the "Recognition Act"),  
15 California Code of Civil Procedure §§ 1713 *et seq.*, of final judgments entered by the High  
16 Court of Justice, Queen's Bench Division in London, England against each of the  
17 Defendants (the "Judgments").

18 This motion is made upon the ground that there is no genuine issue of any material  
19 fact, and that, as a matter of law, each of the criteria for recognition of the Judgments in the  
20 Recognition Act is satisfied and none of the statutory bases for non-recognition exist.

21 This motion is also made on the ground that the Judgments are entitled to full  
22 recognition and enforcement pursuant to traditional principles of international comity as  
23 understood and applied by the courts of the United States and the State of California.

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
